The Organising Authority is the Goolwa Regatta Yacht Club Inc. (GRYC), Goolwa, Australia.

Wednesday 27th - Saturday 30th December 2017

NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES

The race will be governed by the Rules as defined in the current Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) except as altered by the GRYC standard Sailing Instructions.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- Monohull dinghies and yachts which comply with the Australian Trailable Yacht and Sports Boat Rule are eligible to enter these races.
 - Division 2 Yachts without spinnakers
 - o Division 3 Yachts with spinnakers
 - o Division 4 Dinghies
- All yachts in divisions 2 and 3 must display their division flag (available for purchase from the GRYC).
- All yachts must have conspicuous sail numbers.
- Boat rating values will be the same as those used in GRYC club racing or as determined by the Race Committee.
- Visiting yachts are to advise their current rating and the club where this is applied on the Entry Form.
- Skippers must be members of an Australian Sailing affiliated club.
- Boats shall enter by completing the GRYC entry form and paying the appropriate fee before 1730 hrs on the day of the race.

3. FEES

- Entry for each race is \$12 for GRYC members and \$20 for visitors.
- Race entries will only be accepted on the GRYC entry from available in the Club House from 1600 hrs each race day.

4. RACE SCHEDULE

- Wednesday 27th, Thursday 28th, Friday 29th and Saturday 30th of December 2017:
 - o 1730 hrs: Briefing at the GRYC
 - o 1800 hrs: First warning signal
- The starting order will be announced at the briefing.
- Four races over four days, no drops.

5. PRIZES

- Trophies will be awarded for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place on corrected.
- Series place getters in Divisions 2 and 3 will be awarded Nautilus Marine Insurance Vouchers, non-transferrable.

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

See www.gryc.com.au/racing/ for a copy of the standard GRYC sailing instructions.

7. COURSE

- Each race will take place in the area between the Goolwa Barrage and Laffin Point of approximately 60 minutes duration
- Course diagrams will be available in the GRYC Club House prior to each race briefing.

8. SAFETY

This is a Category 6 race.

9. DISCLAIMER

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organising authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

10. INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$10 000 000 (ten million) per incident of the equivalent.
