Goolwa to Wellington Race and Cruise

Saturday April 13, 2019

CRUISERS AND LANDCREW: This is a great opportunity for sail and motor cruisers to join in and have a great weekend on the water. Land crew can easily travel by road and hear all the stories at the Wellington celebrations!

COURSE: from Goolwa, along the River Murray past Clayton, Point Sturt, along the Southern side of Lake Alexandrina with the finish in the vicinity of Point Pomanda, a distance of approximately 30 nautical miles. While crossing the lake you are never out of sight (in clear conditions) of land in one direction or another. Key landmarks are Point Sturt, the lighthouse at Narrung, Mt. Barker to the north and Pomanda Point on the Wellington side of the lake.

Wellington is a further 5 nautical miles from the proposed finish line through a clearly marked channel and into the River Murray. Beware of fishing nets which may be set within the channel.

AT THE FINISH: Mooring and rafting for approximately 18 boats (we'll have to squeeze up and some raft up parallel to sterns) is available in front of the Wellington Hotel.

Results will be announced as soon as practical, but before dinner. Prizes will be awarded for 1st, 2nd and 3rd (depending on the number of entries) in each division. Corrected times will be calculated using the GRYC Mixed Fleet Ratings (and not Performance Handicap).

Please ensure there is a space available at the wharf for the safety boat.

ACCOMMODATION: is available at the Wellington Hotel or the Wellington Caravan Park which is directly behind the pub.
