NOTICE OF RACE

Sunday 5th of May 2019 to Sunday 29th September 2019

SPONSORED BY BREMERTON WINES

1. ORGANISING AUTHORITY

The Organising Authority will be the Goolwa Regatta Yacht Club (GRYC).

2. RULES

Each race in the Series will be governed by the Rules as defined in the current Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) except as altered by the GRYC standard Sailing Instructions.

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

Each race in the Series is open to all boats which fit into the following Divisions:

Division 1 Vintage River Boats

Division 2 Trailable Yachts without spinnakers

Division 3 Trailable Yachts with spinnakers

Division 6 Large Multihull Yachts with motor

Division 5 "Off the Beach" Catamarans with an AS Yardstick of less than 100

PLEASE NOTE: Once a boat has entered in a division in a Series it must remain in that division for that Series.

Boats shall enter a race in the Series by completing the individual race Entry Form and paying the appropriate fee; \$12 for GRYC members and \$20 for visitors. Payments can be made by cash in person at the club, by emailing to entries@gryc.com.au or by mail to: GRYC Race Committee PO Box 321, Goolwa SA 5214.

The Winter Series is an open Series and visiting yachts are welcome to compete and are eligible for the individual race prizes and the Series prizes. Visiting yachts are to nominate its current rating and the club where this rating is applied on the race Entry Form.

4. RACE SCHEDULE

A Race Briefing for each race will be conducted at the GRYC 30 minutes before the first warning signal. The starting order will be announced at the briefing.

5. SPECIFIC NOTICES OF RACE

An additional NOR may be issued for a particular race in the series if it is necessary to provide specific information for that particular race. It is envisaged that a specific NOR would be issued (at least) for Race 5 and Race 6.

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The 2018-2019 GRYC Sailing Instructions (effective 30 Sept, 2018) will apply to each race in this Series and they can be found on the GRYC website under the "Racing Tab".

Additional Sailing Instructions may also be issued in connection with a specific race and, if issued, they are to be read in conjunction with the GRYC Standard Sailing Instructions.

7. COURSES

A course description will be made available at the sign on desk at GRYC prior to each race briefing.

8. SAFETY

Each race in the Series will be conducted as a Category 7 race under Australian Sailing Special Regulations Part 1.

In addition to complying with the Category 7 requirements, all boats must comply with the additional safety requirements listed in the 2018-2019 GRYC Sailing Instructions.

9. DISCLAIMER

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race.

The Organising Authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

10. INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$10 000 000 (ten million) per incident or the equivalent.
