



# PURPOSE:

These rules shall ensure Goolwa Regatta Yacht Club Inc's (the Club) membership is provided in accordance with the Club's Constitution.

### **1.0 MEMBERSHIP**

# 2.0 SAILABILITY

Part II, Cl9, sub-cl (3) of the Club's Constitution;

The General Committee may, upon such grounds and subject to such terms and conditions as it thinks fit, set a lesser annual subscription fee in respect of one or more members of a class of membership than payable by other members of the same class of membership

# 3.0 FEES AND SUBSCRIPTIONS

Part ii, Cl6, of the Club's Constitution, states Annual subscription fees in respect of forthcoming year become due and payable upon the conclusion of each Annual General Meeting

# 4.0 EARLY BIRD FAMILY DISCOUNT (EBFD)

Under Part ii, Cl9, sub-cl (3) of the Club's Constitution, the EBFD is established as a financial incentive to Senior Members to include their family as members of the Club.

Note: This is not a Class of membership; but a Discount fee applied to families.

Everyone under 'Family' has their own class of membership – Senior/Veteran, Associate and Junior/Student

The following criteria is applied:

• Maximum of two (2) adults (1 Senior/Veteran and 1 Associate) and their children, meeting Junior or Student criteria

The following may request an EBFD:

- Existing Senior/Veteran members may receive the discount when paying Annual Subscription Fees; provided they pay the full amount prior to 30 August in year due
- Existing Senior/Veteran members may receive the discount throughout the year when they join up their immediate family for the first
- New Senior members who join their immediate family at the same time. Pro-rata rules apply

## 5.0 PRO-RATA ANNUAL SUBSCRIPTION FEES

Under Part II, Cl9, sub-cl (3) of the Club's Constitution the pro-rata fee payment process is designed to reduce financial burden on members who join the Club more than halfway during the subscription year.

New members, and current members returning from Leave of Absence, after 1 January of any subscription year, are required to pay the following amount of that year's subscription fees:

• January – 50%, February – 40%, March – 30%, April – 20%, May – 10%, June – No charge

Note: Where a member was ceased due to non-payment of fees at 30 September of that current year; the full annual amount must be paid.

## 6.0 Office of Recreation, Sport and racing SPORTS VOUCHER PROGRAM

GRYC as a Registered Sports Provider entitles Primary School Aged children to receive membership at no cost. The parent/guardian are required to complete a Sports Voucher. The Club will submit via the Sports Voucher portal and receive payment.

## 7.0 CESSATION OF MEMBERSHIP

Part II, Cl10, sub-cl (1) of the Club's Constitution outlines Resignation as a Club member; by

- Expulsion; as per Part III, sub-cl (1)(3)(5)
- Written request and acceptance by General Committee. Provided that if that person is in arrears of subscription fees it may be declined
- Non-payment, before 30 September, of any subscription year and with resolution by the General Committee. Upon receiving payment, The General Committee may re-admit without further nomination
- A Junior member reaching 18 years of age. Where the Junior has been a member for four (4) years they may apply in writing to Secretary for Student, Associate or Senior membership. Where they do not meet this requirement, they are required to make a Membership Application

### 8.0 LEAVE OF ABSENCE (LoA)

Under Part II, Cl10, sub-cl (2) of the Club's Constitution:

The General Committee may, upon the written application of any member, and upon such grounds and subject to such terms and conditions as it thinks fit, grant a leave of absence from membership to that member

Any member may request in writing to the Secretary a period of one (1) year of Leave of Absence. The General Committee may grant such.

Under Part II, Cl10, sub-cl (3) of the Club's Constitution:

Any member who has received Leave of Absence from membership pursuant to sub-clause (2) hereof, during the period of absence, is not;

- (a) Obliged to pay annual subscription fees, nor;
- (b) Entitled to exercise any rights or privileges of a member of the Club
