1. ORGANISING AUTHORITY

The Organising Authority will be the Goolwa Regatta Yacht Club (GRYC).

2. RULES

The race will be governed by the Rules as defined in the current Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) except as altered by the GRYC standard Sailing Instructions.

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

The race is open to all boats which fit into the following Divisions:

Division 1 River Boats and Restricted 21 Boats

Division 2 Trailable Yachts without spinnakers

Division 3 Trailable Yachts with spinnakers

Division 6 Multihull Yachts with motor

Cruising yachts and motorboats are encouraged to accompany the racing fleet and signal their intention to do so by completing the entry form. There is no entry fee for cruising yachts or motorboats.

Boats shall enter by completing the attached Entry Form and paying the appropriate fee; \$15 for GRYC members and \$20 for visitors. Payments can be made by cash in person at the club, by emailing to entries@gryc.com.au or by mail to: GRYC Race Committee PO Box 321, Goolwa SA 5214.

Entries will be accepted up to 1300 hrs on the 26th of October 2019.

Visiting yachts are to nominate its current rating and the club where this rating is applied on the race Entry Form.

4. RACE SCHEDULE

Saturday 26th of October 2019:

1330 hrs: Briefing at the GRYC

1400 hrs: First warning signal

The starting order will be announced at the briefing.

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The 2019-2020 GRYC Sailing Instructions (effective 1 Oct, 2019) will apply to this race and they can be found on the GRYC website under the "Racing Notice Board" tab.

6. COURSE

A course will be set from Goolwa upstream towards and possibly beyond Clayton. The actual course will be set on the Race Day after considering the wind conditions on that day.

A course description will be made available at the sign on desk at GRYC prior to the race briefing.

7. DESTINATION

Irrespective of which course is sailed, for those crews who wish to stay overnight, the destination is Wally's Landing, 2Nm upstream from the entrance to the reeds. A flyer detailing arrangements and facilities will be posted on the GRYC website.

8. SAFETY

This race will be conducted as a Category 7 race under Australian Sailing Special Regulation Part 1. In addition to complying with the Category 7 requirements, all boats must comply with the additional safety requirements listed in the 2019-2020 GRYC Sailing Instructions.

9. DISCLAIMER

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organising authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

10. INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$10 000 000 (ten million) per incident or the equivalent.
