



Goolwa Regatta Yacht Club Inc.

Club Rules



1. Conduct on the Club Premises or Marina

A member, while present on or about any premises or marina owned or occupied by the Club, must:

- (a) conduct him/herself in an orderly and peaceable manner, and
- (b) refrain from any conduct which is likely to injure annoy or offend any reasonable person or cause the loss of or damage to any property owned by the Club or any of its Members.

2. Visitors, Guests and Children

A Member who brings or introduces a visitor, guest or child to any premises or marina owned or occupied by the Club, must ensure that such person complies with these Club Rules in the same manner as if that person was a Member of the Club.

3. Condition of the Clubhouse

All Members using the Clubhouse, or any part thereof must leave the same in a clean, orderly and secure condition.

4. Clothing Standards

A Member, while present in any part of the Clubhouse where alcoholic beverages are commonly sold or consumed, must be attired in clothing of not less than a neat casual standard and must wear footwear. Members and visitors must remove hats before entering the Kinnear Room. Exemptions for special occasions may be determined by the General Committee

5. Alcoholic Beverages

A Member must not, at any time when alcoholic beverages are available for purchase from the Clubhouse, consume within the Clubhouse or the immediate vicinity thereof any alcoholic beverage which has not been purchased from the Club.

6. Smoke-free Policy

All club facilities are to be completely smoke-free. Smoking will not occur within a 5 metre radius of entry/exit points to seated areas, toilets, change rooms, food outlets, bars and thoroughfares.

7. Animals

(a) A Member must not cause or allow any animal to enter or be brought into or to remain in any part of the Clubhouse.

(b) Any Member who brings onto or allows any animal to remain on any premises or marina owned or occupied by the Club must ensure that such animal does not behave in a manner which is likely to injure or annoy any reasonable person or cause the loss of/or damage to any property owned by the Club or its Members.

(c) Alexandrina Council regulations require that:

Dogs must be on a leash between the hours of 10am and 6pm on all beaches, foreshores and Council Reserves, within the Alexandrina Council District. Dogs may be off-leash and under "effective control" between 6pm and 10am on all beaches, foreshores and Council Reserves, within the Alexandrina Council. These restrictions apply 7 days a week, throughout the year. Whilst in all other public places, dogs must be restrained on a secure leash at all times.

8. Cooking

A Member who uses cooking or eating equipment, appliances or utensils owned by the Club, must properly clean them and return them to the place where they are normally stored as soon as possible after use.

9. Speed Limit for Vessels

A Member must not operate a vessel at a speed of more than (4) four knots within the Club marina or within (40) forty metres of the Club boat ramp and marina area.

10. Use of Boat Ramp

A Member must not use or occupy the Club boat ramp or any part thereof:

- (a) for any purpose other than the launching or retrieving of a vessel, or
- (b) for any period of time longer than is reasonably necessary for the purpose of or in connection with the efficient launching or retrieving of a vessel.

11. Speed Limit for Motor Vehicles

A Member must not drive a motor vehicle at a speed more than (10) ten kilometres per hour on any part of any premises owned or occupied by the club.

12. Fishing

A Member must not, while on any marina or jetty owned or occupied by the Club, or any vessel moored at any such marina or jetty, use any apparatus or device for the purpose of catching or obtaining fish.

13. Overnight Accommodation in the Clubhouse

A Member must not use the Clubhouse or any part thereof for the purpose of overnight accommodation unless that Member has previously obtained the consent of a member of the General Committee.

14. Keys

All keys issued by the Club to any part of any premises or marina owned or occupied by the Club, remain the property of the Club at all times and must be returned to the Club forthwith upon demand by the General committee, or after a person in possession of such a key cease to be a Member of the Club.

15. Compliance with Directions

All Members, while present on or about any premises of marina owned or occupied by the Club, must comply with any lawful and reasonable directions:

- (a) given to them by a member of the General Committee or the Club Manager, or
- (b) displayed on any sign or notice located on or about any such premises or marina.

16. Electrical Appliances

An electrical appliance is not to be connected to a mains power supply on the GRYC's Carless Marina (the Marina) unless that appliance has water proof joints and is connected in such a way that neither it nor any associated power cord causes any obstruction or hazard to any person using the Marina. If the Club Manager or, in their absence, any member of the General Committee forms the opinion that an electrical appliance is connected to a mains power supply on the Marina contrary to this then they may disconnect that appliance, and neither them nor the Club shall be liable for any loss of or damage to any property resulting from that disconnection.

17. Policy & Procedure

Compliance with all Policy and Procedures put into place by the GRYC General Committee.
