

# Goolwa Regatta Yacht Club Inc. LAKE ALEXANDRINA CLASSIC GOOLWA TO MILANG RACE NOTICE OF RACE AND ENTRY FORM



# Sunday 10<sup>th</sup> of March 2019

### SPONSORED BY DSM LANDSCAPE AND BUILDING SUPPLIES

### 1. ORGANISING AUTHORITY

The Organising Authority will be the Goolwa Regatta Yacht Club (GRYC).

### 2. RULES

The race will be governed by the Rules as defined in the current Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) except as altered by the GRYC standard Sailing Instructions.

### 3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

The race is open to all boats which fit into the following Divisions:

**Division 2** Trailable Yachts without spinnakers **Division 3** Trailable Yachts with spinnakers **Division 5** "Off the Beach" catamarans, yardstick less than 120 **Division 6** Multihull Yachts with motor

Cruising yachts and motorboats are encouraged to accompany the racing fleet and signal their intention to do so by completing the entry form. There is no entry fee for cruising yachts or motorboats.

Boats shall enter by completing the attached Entry Form and paying the \$30 entry fee. Payments can be made by cash in person at the club, by emailing to <a href="mailto:gryc@gryc.com.au">gryc@gryc.com.au</a> or by mail to: GRYC Race Committee PO Box 321, Goolwa SA 5214.

Entries will be accepted up to 1000 hrs on the day of the race, 10<sup>th</sup> of March 2019.

A Sign On sheet will be at the GRYC desk and a Sign Off sheet at MRC.

A visiting yacht must nominate its current rating and the club where this rating is applied on the race Entry Form.

### 4. RACE SCHEDULE

Sunday 10<sup>th</sup> of March 2019:

1030 hrs: Briefing at the GRYC 1100 hrs: First warning signal

The starting order will be announced at the briefing.

### 5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The 2018-2019 GRYC Sailing Instructions (effective 30 Sept, 2018) will apply to this race and they can be found on the GRYC website under the "Racing Tab".

### 6. TIME LIMIT

In addition to the time limits specified in 14.1 of the GRYC standard Sailing Instructions, for this race the final cut-off time for all boats is 1730 hrs.

### 7. COURSE

The course will be from Goolwa, upstream past Clayton, through Gate 1 around Point Sturt, then across Lake Alexandrina through Gate 2 (about half way), then on to the finish line at Milang. Gate 2 will be set within 2 NM of the shoreline and marked by large yellow inflatable buoys approximately 150 m apart. A boat will be stationed at one end displaying an orange flag and a flashing white light.

A course description will be made available at the sign on desk at GRYC prior to the race briefing. A course diagram is also appended to this NOR.

### 8. THE FINISH

The finishing line will be between 2 large orange inflatable buoys near the Milang Jetty. A race committee boat will be moored at the starboard end of the finishing line.

### 9. SAFETY

This race will be conducted as a Category 7 race under Australian Sailing Special Regulation Part 1 and, in addition to complying with the Category 7 requirements, all boats must comply with the additional safety requirements listed in the 2018-2019 GRYC Sailing Instructions.

For this race, GRYC Standard Sailing Instruction Clause 1.15 is amended to read "A VHF radio is mandatory *(except for OTB catamarans)* for all races for which all or part of the course is set upstream of the entrance to Dunn's Lagoon."

### 10. RIGGING, LAUNCHING and MOORING

At Goolwa entrants may use the GRYC car park and ramp for rigging and launching. The grassed area to the South of the GRYC car park may also be used for rigging and launching OTB classes. Cars with trailers attached are to be parked in the grassed area to the South of the GRYC car park. NO PARKING OF CARS AND TRAILERS IN THE GRYC CAR PARK PLEASE. Limited visitor berths are available at the GRYC, please contact the GRYC Manager, on 8555 2617 or gryc@gryc.com.au. Mooring is also available on Lush's Jetty which bounds the 'pond' adjacent to the GRYC Marina.

### 11. WATER TAXIS

A limited water taxis service (designated operating times) will be available to transport crews between boats moored in the reeds and the Milang Jetty. These operating periods will be announced at Goolwa.

### 12. POST RACE ACTIVITIES

The MRC will be offering full bar facilities and post-race sustenance in the evening following the race. A BBQ dinner will be available, and the MRC bar will be open until late.

Breakfast will be available the following morning.

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$10 000 000 (ten million) per incident of the equivalent.
